The Application Site is part of the Northern Gateway Allocation (JPA1.1) in the Places for Everyone Joint Development Plan. It is located east of Bury and south of Heywood, spanning both Bury and Rochdale. In Bury, it is bordered by Brightley Brook, Pilsworth Fisheries, and Whittle Brook. In Rochdale, it is bounded by Pilsworth Road, Heywood Distribution Park, the M62 corridor, Moto Birch Services, and Whittle Fold Farm. The site surrounds Birch Industrial Park and existing properties near Moss Hall Road, lying west of the South Heywood Masterplan Area.
